Piha SLSC was founded in 1934. It has a proud history, is steeped in tradition and honour. With the lifeguards motto "In it for life" many lifeguards continue lifeguarding well into their 50's and 60's, we even have a patrol aptly named 'Grey Patrol'.

The Club offers a comprehensive system that trains juniors as Nippers from 5 until they qualify as lifeguards at 14. First aid, specialist IRB operator, leadership and incident management are some of the many skills lifeguards can also learn.

Piha SLSC is very proud of their volunteer guards who do an exceptional job of patrolling one of NZ's largest and most dangerous beaches. They volunteer their spare time to patrol over the summer months whilst continuing to train in first aid, remain fit and constantly upskill their lifeguarding knowledge.

As well as being a volunteer lifeguard, many compete regularly at surf sport competitions where the events replicate the skills they need to carry out rescues.
