Subject: COVID-19 Memo #14 – Move to Alert Level 1

On Monday 8 June New Zealand Government announced that from midnight tonight, the country will be moving to COVID-19 Alert Level 1. See below for summary of Capability/Operational Compliance Under Alert Level 1; **Note:** There is very little clarification needed as its pretty much business as usual except for contract tracing in some instances.

- **Surf Lifesaving & Club Staff**
 - Working and interacting as per normal.
 - No restrictions on local/regional/national travel or flights.
- **Lifesaving Operations**
 - ECOS as per SOPs' need to be COVID-19 PPE compliant.
 - Normal Patrol Operations can occur.
 - No restrictions on local/regional/national travel or flights.
- **Clubs/Facilities**
 - Club facilities are open to public and membership as per normal.
 - i. Use contact tracing log or APP for all club members and members of public whilst using club facilities.
- **Education/Learning/Training Courses**
 - Normal training can occur.
 - Beach Education as per normal at registered venues.
 - No restrictions on local/regional/national travel or flights.
- **Sport/Physical Recreation & Trainings/Junior Surf**
 - Events can run as normal.
 - i. All SLSNZ events that use the EnterNow system for entries will meet contact tracing requirements, any club run events that do not use the EnterNow need to consider contact tracing processes.
 - Coached physical training sessions can be run as per normal.
 - i. Contact tracing should fall under normal risk management processes.
 - Junior Surf sessions can be run as per normal.
 - i. Contact tracing should fall under normal risk management processes.
 - No restrictions on local/regional/national travel or flights.

To round this phase of operational challenges out, I would like to sincerely express my thanks and gratitude to all our, clubs, members and staff around the country for their understanding and willingness to work positively through this challenge.
